R3011 triangular cabinet downlight

Please read instructions before commencing installation and retain for future reference.



Specification:

12V 20W cabinet light in triangular surround suitable for surface or recessed mounting, with G4 lampholder

Protection against electric shock: Class III (Safety extra low voltage)

Lamp type:12V G4 capsule max. 20WDimensions:Width 125mm, overall length 120mm, depth 40mmTemperature range:-20°C < ta < 40°C</td>Supply:12V (from safety extra low voltage transformer)

Minimum distance from illuminated object is 0.2m

Warning! To prevent overheating, the fitting or its transformer must not be covered by thermal insulation

Complies with EN60598 (BS4533)

Installation:

Electrical products can cause death or injury, or damage to property. This product must be installed only by a competent electrician.

- 1 Ensure mains supply is switched off
- 2 Remove lamphead from triangular surround
- 3 Fix surround to surface with screw through mounting tab
- 4 Connect transformer output to lamp holder leads
- 5 Push lamphead into place in triangular surround

Note: for recessed installation, make 55 mm cutout in mounting surface and push in lamp head, discarding triangular surround.

6 Lamp installation and replacement:

Switch off mains: slide flat bladed screwdriver between glass and retaining ring and gently lever out ring. Take care not to let glass fall. Ensure lamp covers are replaced after the new lamp is inserted. Hold the lamp with tissue paper in order to avoid touching the glass of the lamp with bare hand. Wipe off any fingerprint from the glass immediately.
